## MEASUREMENTS AND MATERIALS

**Shawl:** Approximately 126 cm (49½ ins) square - excluding edging  
**Cot Blanket:** Approximately 70 cm (27½ ins) wide; 105 cm (41½ ins) long - excluding edging

**SUPERSOFT CUDDLES DK** 100g balls  
**Shawl:** 9  
**Cot Blanket:** 5

**Shawl:** One pair each of knitting needles size 4½mm (7)

**Cot Blanket:** One pair each of knitting needles size 4mm (8) and 4½mm (7)

The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

## TENSION

This pattern is based on a standard tension of 22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm (4 in), measured over stocking stitch on 4mm needles.

**N.B. When working triangles, each row starts with a yarn forward and back over needle before first st is worked to give a picot (looped) edge.**

## SHAWL

### Triangles (make 16)

Using 4½ mm needles and leaving a length of yarn 50 cm long for joining up, cast on one st and work (k1, p1, k1) all into this st.

**\*\* 1st row:** Yf (see note), k1, (k1, p1, k1) all into next st, k1. (6 sts)

**2nd row:** Yf, k1, p3, k2.

**3rd row:** Yf, k3, yf, k1, yf, k3. (10 sts)

**4th row:** Yf, k2, p5, k3.

**5th row:** Yf, k5, yf, k1, yf, k5. (14 sts)

**6th row:** Yf, k3, p7, k4.

**7th row:** Yf, k7, yf, k1, yf, k7. (18 sts)

**8th row:** Yf, k4, p9, k5.

**9th row:** Yf, k9, yf, k1, yf, k9. (22 sts)

**10th row:** Yf, k5, p11, k6.

**11th row:** Yf, k11, yf, k1, yf, k11. (26 sts)

**12th row:** Yf, k6, p13, k7.

**13th row:** Yf, k13, yf, k1, yf, k13. (30 sts)

**14th row:** Yf, k7, p15, k8.

**15th row:** Yf, k15, yf, k1, yf, k15. (34 sts)

**16th row:** Yf, k8, p17, k9.

**17th row:** Yf, k9, sl 1, k1, pssso, k13, k2 tog, k9. (34 sts)

**18th row:** Yf, k9, p15, k10.

**19th row:** Yf, k10, sl 1, k1, pssso, k11, k2 tog, k10. (34 sts)

**20th row:** Yf, k10, p13, k11.

**21st row:** Yf, k11, sl 1, k1, pssso, k9, k2 tog, k11. (34 sts)

**22nd row:** Yf, k11, p11, k12.

**23rd row:** Yf, k12, sl 1, k1, pssso, k7, k2 tog, k12. (34 sts)

**24th row:** Yf, k12, p9, k13.

**25th row:** Yf, k13, sl 1, k1, pssso, k5, k2 tog, k13. (34 sts)

**26th row:** Yf, k13, p7, k14.

**27th row:** Yf, k14, sl 1, k1, pssso, k3, k2 tog, k14. (34 sts)

**28th row:** Yf, k14, p5, k15.

**29th row:** Yf, k15, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, k2 tog, k15. (34 sts)

**30th row:** Yf, k15, p3, k16.

**31st row:** Yf, k16, sl 1, k2 tog, pssso, k16. (34 sts)

**32nd row:** Yf, k16, p1, k17.

**33rd row:** Yf, k to end. (36 sts)

**34th row:** As 33rd row.

**35th row:** As 33rd row.

**36th row:** Yf, k1, p to last st, k1.

**37th row:** Yf, k2, \*yf, k2 tog, rep

from \* to last st, k1. (40 sts)

**38th row:** As 36th row.

Rep 33rd row 5 times. (46 sts)

**44th row:** As 36th row.

Work diamond pattern band as follows:

**45th row:** Yf, k2, \*yf, sl 1, k2 tog, pssso, yf, k5, rep from \* to last 5 sts, yf, sl 1, k2 tog, pssso, yf, k2. (48 sts)

**46th row:** As 36th row.

**47th row:** Yf, k1, k2 tog, \*yf, k3, yf, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, k2 tog, rep from \* to last 6 sts, yf, k3, yf, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1. (50 sts)

**48th row:** As 36th row.

**49th row:** Yf, k1, k2 tog, \*yf, k5, yf, sl 1, k2 tog, pssso, rep from \* to last 8 sts, yf, k5, yf, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1. (52 sts)

**50th row:** As 36th row.

**51st row:** Yf, k4, \*yf, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, k2 tog, yf, k3, rep from \* to last st, k1. (54 sts)

**52nd row:** As 36th row.

**53rd row:** Yf, k6, \*yf, sl 1, k2 tog, pssso, yf, k5, rep from \* to last st, k1. (56 sts)

**54th row:** As 36th row. \*\*

Rep 33rd row 5 times. (62 sts)

**60th row:** As 36th row.

**61st row:** As 37th row. (64 sts)

**62nd row:** As 36th row.

Rep 33rd row 5 times. (70 sts)

**68th row:** As 36th row.  
Rep rows 45 to 54 inclusive. (81 sts)  
Rep 33rd row 5 times. (86 sts)  
**84th row:** As 36th row.  
**85th row:** As 37th row. (88 sts)  
**86th row:** As 36th row.  
Rep last 8 rows once more. (97 sts)  
Rep 33rd row 4 times.  
Cast off loosely knitwise and fasten off, leaving a 50cm length of yarn for joining up.  
**Border:** Using 4½mm needles, cast on 14 sts.  
\*\*\* **1st and every alt row:** (Wrong side) K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.  
**2nd row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k3, yf, k4, yf, k2 tog, yf, k2. (16 sts)  
**4th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k4, sl 1, k2 tog, pssso, k1, (yf, k2 tog) twice, k1. (14 sts)  
**6th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k3, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, (yf, k2 tog) twice, k1. (13 sts)  
**8th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, (yf, k2 tog) twice, k1. (12 sts)  
**10th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k1, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, (yf, k2 tog) twice, k1. (11 sts)  
**12th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, yf, k1, yf, k2 tog, yf, k2. (12 sts)  
**14th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k2, yf, k3, yf, k2 tog, yf, k2. (14 sts)  
These 14 rows form border pattern.  
Cont in patt for a further 28 rows, marking beg of last row with a coloured thread (corner section).

Work 23 pattern repeats, marking beg of last row with a coloured thread. \*\*\*  
Rep from \*\*\* to \*\*\* 3 times more.  
Cast off.

## COT BLANKET

**Triangles** (make 24)  
Using 4mm needles and leaving a length of yarn 50 cm long for joining up, cast on one st and work (k1, p1, k1) all into this st.  
Follow instructions for Shawl Triangles from \*\* to \*\*.  
Rep 33rd row 4 times.  
Cast off loosely knitwise and fasten off, leaving a 50cm length of yarn for joining up.  
**Border:** Using 4½mm needles, cast on 14 sts.  
\*\*\* **1st and every alt row:** (Wrong side) K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.  
**2nd row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k3, yf, k4, yf, k2 tog, yf, k2. (16 sts)  
**4th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k4, sl 1, k2 tog, pssso, k1, (yf, k2 tog) twice, k1. (14 sts)  
**6th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k3, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, (yf, k2 tog) twice, k1. (13 sts)  
**8th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, (yf, k2 tog) twice, k1. (12 sts)  
**10th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k1, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, (yf, k2 tog) twice, k1. (11 sts)  
**12th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, yf, k1, yf, k2 tog, yf, k2. (12 sts)

(12 sts)  
**14th row:** Sl 1, yf, k2 tog, k2, yf, k3, yf, k2 tog, yf, k2. (14 sts)  
These 14 rows form border pattern.  
Cont in patt for a further 28 rows, marking beg of last row with a coloured thread (corner section).  
Work 20 pattern repeats, marking beg of last row with a coloured thread (this section fits along side of Blanket).  
Work 3 pattern repeats, marking beg of last row with a coloured thread then work 13 pattern repeats, marking beg of last row with a coloured thread (this section fits along shorter edge of Blanket).\*\*\*  
Rep from \*\*\* to \*\*\* once more.  
Cast off.

## MAKE UP

**Both Versions:** Linking picot edges together either by sewing or with a crochet hook and taking care to match pattern, join triangles into 4 squares for Shawl or 6 squares for Cot Blanket.  
**Shawl:** Join these squares into one large square. Sew marked edges of border to Shawl, gathering shorter sections between markers for corners then sew border seam neatly.  
**Cot Blanket:** Join these squares to form an oblong two squares wide by three squares long. Sew marked edges of border to Shawl, gathering shortest sections between markers for corners then sew border seam neatly.
